

Mita-Teknik A/S – RoHS Statement


At Mita-Teknik we wish to make our contribution to the protection of the environment. Mita-Teknik commits to continuously maintain and develop our line of products for the purpose of providing zero solutions with regard to the contents of chemicals and other hazardous substances.

RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) is a European Union Directive, which restricts the use of hazardous materials found in electrical and electronic products.

The original RoHS was published as Directive 2002/95/EC. Later RoHS 2 was published as Directive 2011/65/EU.

Mita-Teknik's products, for installation in wind turbines, are excluded from the scope of the Directive as per the corresponding exclusion in Directive 2011/65/EU article 2 (4) and article 3 (4).

Even that Mita-Teknik's products are excluded from the RoHS Directive, we support the basic aim of RoHS in improving the protection of human health and environment and the main part of our product line fulfils the RoHS requirements, but with limited exceptions, due to the comprehensive requirements for load, reliability and safety through the entire lifetime of our products.
